Refractive Surgery is not a covered benefit.¹ The full fee must be paid by the patient prior to the procedure. Payment may be made with cash, Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Discover card, or a certified or cashier's check payable to "Kaiser Permanente" (we do not accept personal checks).

Payment may be made at the Kaiser Permanente Honolulu Medical Office on the day of your prescreening or during clinic hours anytime before your scheduled procedure.

For your convenience, credit card payment can be made by phone by calling us at **1-866-400-1760 (TTY 711)**. Please note that payment must be received at least one day prior to your surgery date.

The price includes your comprehensive screening exam, your LASIK procedure with intralase technology, one year of post-operative care, and enhancements within two years.
